Facts You Should Know

NO GPS tracking device company owns or operates its own cellular phone network.

The U.S. Government grants licenses for companies to own and operate cell phone communications networks. There are only 4 or 5 such major communication companies authorized to operate in North America.

NO GPS tracking device company owns a cell tower or leases part of a network.

The U.S. Government does not allow nor do any major communication companies sub-lease their networks which have an estimated annual cost in the hundreds of millions of dollars.

GPS tracking device companies use cellular networks in partnership with major carries.

Through the use of cellular networks GPS tracking device companies are able to transmit over the carrier's data channels. This allows for secure data transmission of the vehicles location to the device companies servers and ultimately the end user.
